

Doc4aDay – MAFP is partnering with the Maine Medical Center Department of Medical Education to bring this program to High School students here in Maine Doc4aDay:

- Is a community outreach program to spark an interest in a career in health care
- Engages disadvantaged high school students who show academic promise
- Involves an introduction about the pathway to healthcare career
- Engages students through hands-on suturing in the skills lab, participation in high-fidelity simulated patient scenarios and a question-and-answer session
- Enlists Maine Medical Students to act as the teachers, partnering with





- participants by coaching them directly in their roles in the patient scenarios and teaching them the hands-on skills
- Aims that the hands-on exposure will pique enough interest in the high school student participants that they may consider a career path in the field of medicine, when they otherwise may not have
