The schools we visited in Feb are: DeRac, Ferrier, Ouanaminthe, Roche Platte, and Stanford Kelly. We also have some updated grade levels for Terrier Rouge students. We have talked about the Vigore siblings and their medical needs. While we were there Love Madalie (photo above) was home from school with a fever so we decided to go pay a visit and check up on her. Her eyes and skin are so bad and she definitely needs prayers. When she is older she will need eye surgeries. For now we learned she is not eating much, as in her appetite isn't the greatest. Please pray that she will get her appetite back and eat better. We talked it over and decided to buy them a couple goats. Goats are fairly easy to raise and are used for milk and meat. They can be bred and "kids" sold to earn money to buy other foods. It's an awesome gift for families there. Her brother, Love Kerly, also has skin issues (in doorway).

We have a new child God put in our path this trip. Her name is Fanaïka (photos above left). She has stolen our hearts and the hearts of my folks (THANKS MOM & DAD!), who are now her sponsors. We may soon be asking for donations to help this beautiful little girl. She is three years old, but at about two months old she was severely burned. We have already been in contact with a clinic in Haiti to see about getting her an initial appt, but we have to wait for doctors to visit this clinic. We are also checking into other options. If you feel led to help this child, or any child God puts before us, we do have a medical fund. Please be sure to add a note to your donation..."Haiti medical".

As one child or family is helped we celebrate with praises to the One who puts these before us and shows us how to help. Without Jesus we could never do this.
