Dear Honduras Sponsors and Donors,



We hope you are well and refreshed as it says in Proverbs 11:25. We thank you so much for all your prayers and financial support!! Lots has been happening in Honduras and we would like to let you know about some of it!

In April this year, a group of 11 people visited the three His Hands for Honduras sponsorship communities with Project Compassion, a Christ-Centered organization whose primary purpose is to share God's love by ministering

to the physical and spiritual needs of all people through outreaches. Each day about 250 people met with a doctor, got reading and/or sunglasses, visited the pharmacy, received prayer and love. We were thankful to have doctors, pharmacists, and nurses from Honduras and the U.S. take care of many needy people.



About a month later, we learned about an accident that took the lives of three Honduras pastors whom we loved. One of them was Lesly (in the photo to the left), with whom we worked very closely, as she was in charge of the senior citizens' sponsorship program in Rio Blanco. Her husband Abel (also in the photo) was the director of the Compassion International sponsorship program, but decided to give it up to work with the seniors in Rio Blanco and other sponsorship programs Lesly was in charge of. We miss Lesly and ask for prayer for her family.

We are always met at the airport by a Honduras team that makes us feel welcome and loved. They work right along-side us as we work in Honduras and we feel confident that the children/seniors in their care are in good hands.

In July, 7 people went on our His Hands for Honduras trip to visit the sponsorship programs in the three communities of Rio Blanco, Zolano, and Penasquitos. We

took photos, measured, and interviewed about 188 children for their sponsors. We are very appreciative that 117 children are sponsored and hopeful that the other 71 children will be sponsored soon. We are also asking for donations to help the unsponsored children with meals and education.

In Rio Blanco our 40 seniors are still being fed once a month, thanks to a donor. Usually Pastor Abel preaches and sometimes they get to work on a craft. If a senior in Rio Blanco gets sponsored, s/he gets food and/or medicine, in addition to the meal at the monthly meetings. Sponsorship and/or donations help provide for their needs. If you would like to help a senior citizen who is not sponsored, please see the contact information at the top of the letter.



We like to visit seniors in their homes, because sometimes they have a hard time getting to church. They are so thankful to have us visit them and always tell us how much the food helps them to get through the month. Sometimes we find out that they need medicine and other times we find out that they are doing a lot better, because of the food that they have received.
