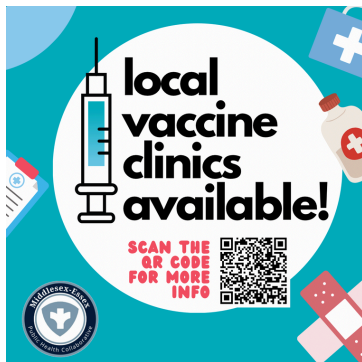
Pre-Requisites: You must complete a 2.5 hour [Opioid Overdose Rescue](#) training prior to taking this course.

Relavent Best Practices

As we use Relavent more often, we learn some best practices to keep in mind:

- **Sync frequently!** It's important to sync your iPad to ensure other inspectors have access to up-to-date information. We recommend syncing the iPad at the end of each day.
- **Don't let your iPad go to sleep.** If your iPad goes to sleep in the middle of an inspection, you may lose your data. Make sure your iPad is set to go to sleep after 10-15 minutes to ensure you don't lose data.
- **Submit issues to Relavent.** Relavent is continually making improvements. When you come across technical issues, submit them to Relavent at support@relavent.freshdesk.com.

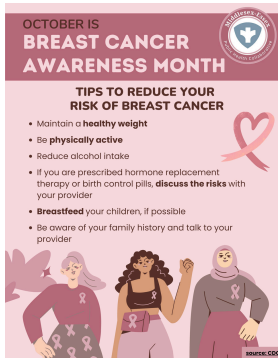

Use this and other graphics created to help promote prevention through flyers, social media and email communications!

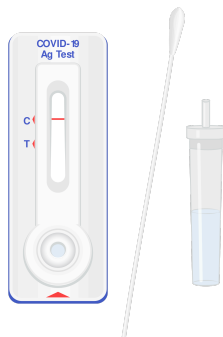
