Due to a recent funding cut to the data solutions program at OLRH, significant changes are being made to the METRIK system—the data solution intended to support inspections, permitting, and nursing services.

DPH is currently collecting feedback from local health staff on which features of METRIK matter most. This is an important opportunity to share your input and highlight priorities—such as the inspectional software component, which has been a key focus in past planning.

Bi-Annual MA Health Data Review

Our regional review of the MA Health Data Tool highlights key gaps in food access, behavioral health, chronic disease, digital literacy, and transportation. Nearly half of residents live in low-access food areas, overdose deaths remain high despite fewer providers, and many households still face limited internet or transportation options. In response, upcoming education efforts will focus on nutrition, substance use, hypertension, diabetes, and health literacy, with in-person sessions on a local guide to better nutrition and resources like WIC, SNAP, and seasonal produce guides. Respiratory Illness Season Resources



This disease trend report aggregates data from the communities of North Andover, Andover, Reading, North Reading, Haverhill and Lynnfield.


Confirmed & Probable Diseases Reported

August 15, 2025 to September 14, 2025




Confirmed & Probable Communicable Diseases

January 1 - September 15, 2025




Confirmed & Probable Influenza & COVID-19 Cases
