## It's Open Enrollment Time; Explore Health and Wellness Benefits That Fit Your Life

Open enrollment runs from May 1 through May 31 and is the time each year for you to review your benefits and make changes. Even if you aren't planning on making changes this year, the *Care and Support That Match Your Life* booklet will provide you with detailed information regarding your health plan options as well as all the valuable programs and services that accompany your health insurance benefits. The Care and Support That Match Your Life booklet provides details on programs and services available through your plan, as well as the benefit changes effective July 1, 2025. Below are some highlights:

MEA Choice Plus and Standard Plan

- Deductible will increase from \$200 to \$300 per member (Referred/ In-network
- level).
- Copay maximum will decrease from \$7,750 to \$7,400 per member.
- Total out-of-pocket will decrease from \$9,450 to \$9,200 per member.

MEA Standard Core Plan(formerly known as the MEA Standard 500 Plan)

- Deductible will increase from \$500 to \$600 per member.
- Copay maximum will decrease from \$6,450 to \$6,100 per member.
- Total out-of-pocket will decrease from \$9,450 to \$9,200 per member.

MEA Choice Plus Value NEW Plan (point of service)

- Access to care providers in the Blue Choice New England POS network including Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, and Vermont.
- \$2,500 individual deductible.
- PCP selection required.
- No PCP referrals necessary but must use participating New England network providers to receive in-network benefits.

MEA Standard Basic Plan (formerly known as the MEA Standard 1000 Plan)

• Deductible will increase from \$1,000 to \$1,100 per member.

- Copay maximum will decrease from \$5,950 to \$5,600 per member.
- Total out-of-pocket will decrease from \$9,450 to \$9,200 per member.

All plans - Prescription drugs

Prescription drug copays for all plans:

- Tier 1a drugs: \$10 copay, no change
- Tier 1b drugs: increase from \$15 to \$20
- Tier 2 drugs: increase from \$35 to \$45
- Tier 3 drugs: increase from \$60 to \$70
- Tier 4 drugs: increase from \$85 to a 20% coinsurance to \$150 maximum per 30-day supply
