These activities focus on building relationships and expectations. Each BARR Team will be presenting to the staff an overview of the components of BARR and its focus. Our behavior referrals for 1st grade this year are 11. Last year at this time they were 75. Last year's K (This year's 1st graders.) were at 32. This year's 4th grade has 22 and last year's fourth grade at this time had 61. Last year's 3rd graders (This year's 4th graders.) had 129 referrals.

Parent Teacher Conferences

We want to thank all of our parents and staff who took part in our conferences this year. We conducted the conferences on November 8th and 9th at both schools. This was a time for parents and guardians to meet with their child's teacher to discuss academic progress and other items as needed.
