## The Alden Mitchell Scholarship

Alden Mithcell was a long-term Legionnaire of the Roderick-Crosby American Legion Post 28. Alden was a World War II Army veteran who served as a teacher in the Farmington school system for many years. Alden retired from Mt. Blue High School. This scholarship is to be awarded to a graduating high school senior that is planning to further their education or training. This does not have to be a four year college. The recipient of this scholarship must have a living parent or grandparent that is a member of an American Legion Post(Legionnaire) or have a living parent or grandparent that has served in the armed forces(Veteran). The recipient may qualify under a deceased parent or grandparent if they were an active member of the American Legion at the time of their death.

The student must submit a written essay on what the scholarship would mean to them with the application, what they did their senior year of High School(participated in clubs, sports, extra curricular activities, worked, etc) The student must have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA at the end of their first semester of college. They must return their transcripts to The Roderick-Crosby Post by Jauary 31.

This scholarship, in the amount of \$300.00 will be awarded to the recipient after they have successfully completed their first semester with a 2.5 GPA and have submitted the documentation to the Roderick-Crosby Post 28 by January 31.
