GFWC (General Federation of Women's Clubs) Maine and the Maine Council for Elder Abuse Prevention (MCEAP) are working together to raise awareness about elder abuse in Maine. GFWC Maine and MCEAP are pleased to announce a \$1,000 scholarship to be awarded to a Maine student who has successfully completed requirements for graduation from a Maine high school in 2026 and who will be attending college or a certification program as a full-time student during the 2026-2027 academic year. A winner will also be selected from each participating county and will be awarded a \$50 scholarship.

Criteria for selection include: an essay with content about elder abuse and your academic average. The completed application should contain: 1. A 550-650 word, double-spaced essay in response to the question: "What is elder abuse and what is your solution?" 2. A copy of your high school transcripts, 3. A letter of acceptance from a college or university as soon as possible but due no later than May 1. Please refrain from including personal information and names of individuals in the essay or using artificial intelligence (AI) in the writing of the essay. If the applicant uses any form of AI in writing the essay, the essay will be disqualified from consideration.
