Anyone applying for a Reverend Maurice Plourde scholarship must meet the following criteria in order to be eligible.

The candidate must be a son or daughter of the members, or a member of, Knights of Columbus Council #320, and/or members of the parishs of St. Rose of Lima in Jay, and St Joseph's in Farmington, and graduating from High School in May or June of the year in which he/she is applying and must start school by the fall semester of that same year. The only exception to this is for a student who is attending a school specifically to enter into religious life. Students pursuing the religious calling would qualify on an annual basis and have first priority to receive a scholarship if there are two or more scholarships available in that year. If the student does not begin and complete the fall semester and enroll for the next semester he/she automatically forfeits his scholarship to an alternate. Proof of matriculation to the next semester is required at the time the scholarship is presented.
