A MESSAGE FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT

With everyone working together, RSU 9 Student Attendance continues to show improvement over last year's numbers! After the first 37 student days of our school year, I am very happy to update that our average daily attendance has continued to improve at each of our schools as compared to last year's numbers. Our overall daily attendance average has increased from to 92.52% to 94.14%! This is an increase in over 1,300 extra days of school attended by our students this year! A 22% decrease in the number of days missed!

Our Chronic Absenteeism Rate for students has also improved with a reduction in students considered Chronically Absent (10% of total days missed), reducing from 620 students to 433 students. This number is still way too high, but we need to celebrate that we have a 30% reduction in the number of students overall. Each added day a student attends school is another opportunity for them to learn, share, be supported by our staff, their friends, and classmates!

Special thanks goes to our students for seeing the importance of attending school each day and to our parents and guardians for working with us to ensure that our students get to take advantage of the many opportunities afforded to them by the communities of RSU 9!







Yurt Update November 2023





First mentioned in the June 2, 2023 newsletter, the largest Project-Based Learning project undertaken at Foster CTE is a project where students are building the classroom that will house the program in future years - a 30' diameter Yurt. From September through late December 2022 students in the Outdoor Leadership Program and Pre-engineering program completed site preparation work and created the base for the building followed by the construction of the yurt itself. Over the summer, progress continued with new flooring, an ADA ramp, new front steps, railings on decks, the ramp and steps, three drainage ditches, an outdoor kitchen, and storage shed were built. The yurt is now used for daily Outdoor Leadership classes, Program Advisory Committee meetings, Trades 4 ME freshmen girls, and yoga (Yogurt...). And there is more to come!

PROGRESS ON THE MBMS BJORN CENTER




Construction of the Mt. Blue Middle School's Bjorn Center for Career and Technical Education is on
