A message from Superintendent Elkington

School year 2022-2023 has been a year of two important firsts. It was the inaugural year for the Outdoor Leadership Program at Foster CTE and the first Annual Special Olympics Western Maine Bocce Tournament was held at RSU 9. Both provide exciting new opportunities for our students. Additionally, not a first, but an ongoing example of the success our students have in using their interests and talents in the greater world - The Blue Crew, our RSU 9 Robotics Team, has had another very successful year! We look forward to their continued efforts at reaching for the stars!

Outdoor Leadership Program

During the Outdoor Leadership Program's (OLP) first year at Foster CTE students engaged in multiple hands-on outdoor, experiential, and Project Based Learning (PBL) opportunities designed to prepare them to work as educators, instructors, or facilitators in parks, recreational facilities, camps, and other outdoor settings. Students built Nordic ski pulks, learned mountain bike maintenance, carved their own canoe paddles with the Maine Local Living School, learned ski operations at Saddleback Mountain, and earned multiple certifications relating to the industry. The largest PBL project students engaged in was creating the classroom that

will house the program in future years. RREV Award seed money was used to acquire a 30' diameter Yurt kit.
Students from the OLP and Pre-Engineering program spent September until late December building the yurt. After participants passed hand tool safety training provided by the Building Trades instructor, they began with site





preparation work and created the base for the building followed by the construction of the yurt itself. The structural insulated floor was assembled in a day with help from visiting students from Day Mountain Middle School. The project will continue into the summer with addition of an ADA compliant ramp and completion of the deck. It has been
