

HALLOWEEN WINDOW PAINTING CONTEST: Rules and Guidelines

Saturday, October 26th, 2024

10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Sponsored by the Farmington Rotary Club

Registration will take place in front of the Pierce House on Main Street starting at 10:00 a.m. Window locations are assigned by GRADE. Painting will take place between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Judging will start promptly at 12:00 p.m.

* Contestant are responsible for bringing the following, one for <u>each</u> child participating:

- 1. Containers for paints (muffin tins, egg cartons, etc.)
- 2. Paint brushes for child
- 3. Small amount of water (1-2 cups) to mix with paint powder
- 4. Newspaper to place on sidewalk under the windows
- 5. Cleaning up any litter when finished painting window
- 6. Locating the window assigned by number to each child

* There will be four classifications for judging:

a) Preschool & Kindergarten b) Grades 1 & 2 c) Grades 3 & 4 d) Grades 5 & 6

* Window painting will be judged on originality, neatness of painting and area, Halloween or autumn theme. 1st Prize \$20, 2nd Prize \$10, 3rd Prize \$5; will be awarded in each classification by the Farmington Rotary Club.

* For pre-sketching, only chalk may be used. Only the powdered water paints supplied free by the Downtown Business and Professional Association and the Farmington Rotary Club are allowed to be used in the contest. These paints are obtained at the registration desk. Contestants **CANNOT** bring their own paints.

* Judging will take place on Saturday at noon. The decision of the judges will be final. Prizes will be awarded by the Farmington Rotary Club and can be picked up the following week at the winner's school. Preschool parents will be notified by phone and arrangements can be made for pick up of the award.

* Each contestant must fill out the application form below and present it at the registration table to enter the contest and get a window assignment.
