You can help to create a generous donation to the Care and Share Food Closet by reading this summer. The library will give five cents for every book under 100 pages and more for longer books. Children of all ages, readers and listeners can join.

Begins June 17, 2020 and ends August 11, 2020

You must register and keep a record of your reading.

In person, by mail, email or phone, I need full names, phone numbers, email addresses, ages and school names for the fall.

Recording sheets can be picked up, scanned or mailed, or you can make up your own based on the point system.

All books under 100 pages are equal to 1 point

100-199 pages = 2 points

200-299 pages = 3 points

300-399 pages = 4 points

400-499 pages = 5 points and so on

Each electronic book hour or each audio cd equals 1 point.

You will need to check in weekly with your new point totals so Joanne can post your progress on the FPL Summer Reading Program Facebook page.

There will be raffles for used books and Gifford Ice Cream cone coupons, I hope. I am waiting for confirmation from Gifford.

The Ten Top readers will win gift certificates from Devaney Doak & Garrett Booksellers.

In addition, there will be regular weekly recorded online story times throughout the summer: Baby Rhymes, Preschool Story Times and Owl Club for children of school age. I am sorry we won't be able to gather in groups.
