 - a. District Phone problems & Upgrade Elkington
 - i. Need to move faster

for salary and benefit increases. These will reduce their overall budget increase to zero or close to zero for 25-26.

 - 1. Review
 - a. Nicole reviewed the current projects
 - i. Fire alarm panel upgrade at MBMS
 - ii. New door at AHS
 - b. Work orders were reviewed.
- b. 10 Yr Plan
 - i. Committee Meetings
 - 1. Have held one Operations Planning Committee meeting-current focus is preventative maintenance.
- c. MBMS Ibarguen/Elkington
 - i. Bjorn Culinary Center
 - 1. Fire marshall will not give a waiver for home hoods. Not allowing anymore waivers based on promosies. It is commercial hood or nothing for schools.
 - 2. Can we find a repurposed hood? Might that impact our insurance? Nicole will do some research.
 - 3. We don't have the money and so will end this final part of the project for the year.
 - ii. GYM
 - 1. Students and sports are using the space!
 - 2. The main doors to the gym and the custodial door need to be installed and has been approved through insurance.
 - 3. Entryway is complete.
 - 4. Bleachers are installed.
 - iii. Basement
 - There has been good progress with paint and sheetrocking. Insurance is reviewing a Specialty Services quote (HVAC) due to the improved quality of the equipment being asked (mega press fittings). Waiting on a final answer.

 - 1. No progress at this time. Nicole is collaborating with Chef Andy.
- d. MBHS Ibarguen
 - i. Gym
 - 1. Post the repair of the eight holes, there was at least one leak. G and E found the issue and also fixed it. Cold temps at this time and therefore no leaks currently. G and E will survey the entire roof in the spring.

- 2. Is this caused by ice jams with the drains? Hard to determine with a flat roof. If you have ice covering a drain and you go to break the ice then you can cause damage to the roof.
