- 5. Strategic Planning Update Harrison
 - a. The Strategic Planning Committee met last Wednesday and will be consistently meeting on Wednesdays. A discussion was heard on ensuring we are hearing all voices of our community.
 - A recommendation that someone representing the business committee was made, and it was shared that it is currently happening. This includes retired members, business owners, rotary, etc.
- 6. CCHS HVAC Questions Elkington
 - a. A review of what was shared at the board meeting. The system at CCHS has been found to be a good system and it is running well. Adjustments can be made to it for seasonal needs. If we would like to add air conditioning to spaces, due to summer programming, it is currently set up to allow some of this to happen.
- 7. Mallett Traffic Study Elkington
 - a. Money is in the RSU 9 budget
 - b. What are the issues?
 - c. Suggested that we should maybe look at more parking instead?
 - i. We probably can add 20 parking places in some areas with reconstruction of the entrance, which could reduce some of the issues in the drop off and pick up area.
 - ii. The SRO officer and principal went over to help remind families to not double park.
