 - iv. Districts on the West Coast had more success in getting public approval if it was a more broad district approach. Overall screen time for all was a factor of concern.
 - v. A whole district approach was recommended-a holistic approach for all.
 - vi. There was good feedback from the school visit to Morse.

 - i. Meeting held on 1/31. 510 applications-strong interest!
 - ii. LD 436 aligns credit/standards for math, English and science with CTE programs-standards alignment. This will allow for students to know what high school

- credits they might be granted in CTE specific programs. FCTEC is developing a template aligned with Westbrook's plan and work as theirs is top-notch.

- b. Maine Through Year Assessment Data Review Poulin
 - i. Assistant Superintendent Monique Poulin (MP) shared a PowerPoint presentation.
 - 1. Reviewed some of the assessments we have been using with varying degrees of success or use.
 - 2. She discussed how we are excited about having all grades with measurable data on a like instrument. NWEA MAP Growth.
 - 3. Having a nationally normed-test will allow us to see how our instructional efforts are supporting student learning as compared to others.
 - 4. The scores will allow us to triangulate our data for MTSS and better inform classroom instruction.
 - 5. MP shared 2024 test results
 - a. She then reviewed scoring guidelines for the differing test scores and where RSU9 students fell by grade level in Reading and Math
 - b. These are a "point in time", "snapshot".
 - i. These data points will be helpful for future planning.
 - 6. MP then shared 2023 test results district-wide.
