 - A. Good news stories from Board/Admin

Doug Dunlap mentioned that there is great interest in our sister city of Lac Megantic in renewing our connections. There may be an opportunity for our French students to visit.

Dr. Pat shared that he is happy that James Black will be our new MBMS principal after spending so many hours in the barn with him.

VI. Public Comment

Lindy Moceus- Spoke to per pupil costs. She stated that CTE was not included last week and she wanted to correct the information. She also shared spreadsheets entitled: "Per Pupil Expenditures by Type 2015-16" and "State-Aggregate Compared to RSU 9". Jen Hebert pointed out that the comparisons on the spreadsheets are not "apples to apples" as not all schools have a tech center or 10 towns in a rural area for transportation. Also, debt service is reimbursed by the state for between at 97-99%. Our schools attract new families and keep property values high. The more students we have, the more reimbursement we receive from the state.

Elaine Graham-wants to have Lindy's data published. She expressed concerns regarding the new MBMS principal's salary including benefits. She also feels that people should move here due to the education we provide vs. our new buildings. Dr. Ward agreed. Elaine also asked for more meetings explaining the Proficiency-Based Education. He reassured her that there would be more meetings on this topic. Lastly, she asked how much money the state has received for special education from Mainecare.
