 - A. MBHS Joel Smith
 - 1. This was a busy summer with a focus on reviewing attendance and campus wide expectations. It is great to have our students back on campus.
 - We welcomed nine international students to MBC who benefit from and enrich our campus. We also have students visiting from the Canary Islands for two weeks in October. There was a question about the J-1 vs. F-1 visas and the funding for the International Student Program.
