- * We were able to fill our vacant 4th grade position in October. We were very happy to welcome Heather McCormick to our staff at AHS.
- * Our K 2 students visited our local Fire Department.
- * We have had 45-50 students consistently attend the 21st Century After School Program at AHS.
- * We had our yearly food drive at AHS headed by Lucinda Drechsler in November. We collected approximately 1,137 items which were donated to the Wilton Food Bank.
- * We have had 4 very successful schoolwide award assemblies at AHS with very good parent and family turnout.
- * Vaccination Clinic We want to thank Kim Lloyd, our school nurse, for hosting our Covid Booster Clinic.
- * We had two very successful Parent/Family Math Nights at both schools in December and want to thank Nancy Ellis (AHS) and Morgan Badeau (Cushing) for organizing these events. Approximately 150 people attend at AHS and 105 at Cushing.
- * On December 8, Tyngtown, a local women's group that raises money to meet Wilton needs, provided breakfast muffins for the staff at both schools while also donating student snacks for both schools.
- * Cushing School received a \$250.00 Grant from the Franklin County Unit of MEA Retired Educators.

 The money will be used towards a school wide assembly.
- * Kid's Can, supervised by Ericka Conloque and Devon Hall, will begin in January.

Assessments

- * Our Fall 22 State Assessment (NWEA) results showed that 56% of our students scored at or above grade level mean scores for Reading at AHS.
- * Our Fall 22 State Assessment (NWEA) results showed that 56% of our students scored at or above grade level mean scores for Math at AHS.
- * Our Fall Developmental Reading (DRA) results showed that 63% of our students met the District's Fall Benchmark score for fluency and comprehension at AHS.
