## **Enrollment**

- We average 320/322 students (at 322/327 today). (All May updates in red)
- The % of boys/girls is about 50/50

## Absenteeism has been very challenging - for teachers, students, and families.

- 317 different students have been out; <u>226 students have missed more than a week</u> of school.
- 129 students have missed 10+ days. 10 students have missed 2 weeks or more in 3rd Quarter.
- 51 students have missed 3-6 weeks of school. 1 student missed 3 weeks in the 3rd Quarter.
- 27 different staff have been absent for a total of 119 days, related to Covid 3 staff out in 3rd Quarter.


#### Academics:

Our professional development efforts have been on Literacy growth and improvement, where we saw the most drop-off in start of year data. Continued focus on the Literacy Framework elements and cross-checking with current practice. Slight dip in math performance for some is considered typical as Quarter 3 expectations, for K, take a steeper trajectory in skills/instruction. In K also - the score is in **text** reading now, instead of Letter ID.

What our data shows currently: black - fall, blue - Jan, red - current

Kindergarten, now: 72% 83%Math (ODT) 80% Lit (DRA) 98% Lit (letter ID) proficient; Fall: 62 %(ODT) M, 86 % Lit 1st Grade, now: 60% 64%Math 51% Lit 39% Lit (DRA) proficient; Fall: 66 % M, 27 % Lit 2nd Grade, now: 60% 48%Math 67% Lit 61% Lit (DRA) proficient; Fall: 74 % M 49 % Lit

**Behavioral**: Office Disciplinary Referrals (ODRs) **presently**: 281 compared to 2021=35, 2020 = 565, 2019=645
