1. Communication

a. Monthly technology messages for staff and families

Instituted a monthly update for both <u>staff</u> (mtbluersd.org Google account required for access) and <u>families</u> to keep both groups in the loop on technology-related issues, solutions, and support.

2. Digital Devices

a. K-5 iPads

Deployed 1000+ student iPads for use in the first week of school.

Year 2 of 3 expected deployment.

b. 6-12 MacBook Air laptops

Deployed 1300+ **new!** student laptops for use in the first week of school. Year 1 of 3 expected deployment.

c. Hotspots

Deployed hotspots to all school libraries, steadily increasing availability as needed.



d. Retired equipment

1100+ retired student laptops were sold and picked up by a reseller. We hope to use proceeds received from this sale to create a technology reserve fund.

3. Technology Professional Development (PD) and Training

a. Calendar

Work began in August with a group of teachers, administrators, and technology coaches to develop a calendar of instructional technology-related sessions.

Created YouTube Channel to host technology-related PD and training videos.

1. Communication

a. Time-sensitive staff updates
