

EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE REGULATION

Membership - The Education Advisory Committee (EAC) shall consist of equal representation from each building appointed by the Association.

Sub-Committee - The EAC shall be authorized to establish sub-committees for specific projects to allow for those who would be affected by EAC recommendations to have an opportunity to be involved.

Individual Initiative for Suggestions - Individual teachers, departments, grade levels, Association Committees, administrators, Board Members, students, parents, or other interested parties shall be encouraged to initiate ideas and suggestions for EAC projects.

Rules of Procedure - The EAC shall establish its own rules of procedure and shall provide for a rotating chairmanship. The chairperson shall be responsible for the arrangement and conduct of meetings.

Information - The EAC and its sub-committees shall be provided the access to available school district information as provided to the Association as specified in Article V, Section A of the Comprehensive Contract.

Reports - The Board may consider and study all written recommendations submitted by the EAC for action.

Budget - As of September 1, 1988, the Board shall provide adequate funds to the EAC to enable it to fulfill its purpose and responsibilities. The funds established shall go through the regular budget process.

Clerical Assistance - Adequate secretarial and clerical assistance shall be provided for the EAC.
