

Creation of Student Clubs, Co/Extra Curricular Activities, Athletic Teams

Student activities are an important part of the total school curriculum. Student activities including athletics, clubs, and organizations provide opportunities for students to explore areas of interest and skill as well as opportunities to learn teamwork, sportsmanship, discipline, leadership, pride, and fairness.

Any individual or group desiring to initiate or create a club, organization, co/extra curricular activity or athletic team must first receive approval of the building principal. Upon approval of the building principal the request must then be approved by the superintendent of schools before going to the Mt. Blue Regional School District's Educational Policy and Finance Committees for determination of if it will go to the full Board of Directors for final approval.

A proposal must be submitted with the following information:

1. Type of club or activity
2. Results of survey to determine number of students interested
3. Definition of who would be eligible to join or participate
4. Number of students who could participate
5. Number of coaches
6. Coaches/advisor stipends (cost and number), if requested
7. Academic requirements to participate
8. Cost for equipment or materials to initiate the activity or program
9. Cost for transportation to attend functions or games
10. Length of season or activity
11. Other information as required by the administration or Board of Directors
