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## **DETENTION OF STUDENTS - PROCEDURE**

Students in Grades 6-12 may be assigned detention for disciplinary reasons in accordance with policy JKB – Detention of Students.

Parents will be notified of all detention.

School officials shall be responsible for supervision during the detention period; however, upon completion of the detention assignment, students must leave the school property and the school shall have no further responsibility for their supervision.

Students assigned detention by either teachers or the main office must report to a designated location on time prepared to work quietly for the entire detention period.

Students at Mt. Blue High School and Mt. Blue Middle School who do not report for detention are subject to further disciplinary action as determined by a building administrator.

In grades below 6 student detention is a building option, subject to limitations set by law.

Detention may be during the school day or after school. In cases when after school detention is utilized, one day's notice will be given to the student and parents in order for transportation from the school following the detention to be arranged. Parents are expected to provide or make plans for transportation after the detention period.

Recess may not be withheld as a consequence for a violation of the Student Code of Conduct for any student in grade five or below, except that when there is no alternative time available, recess time may be used for restorative interventions related to the student's conduct.

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
