The Care and Support That Match Your Life booklet provides details on programs and services available through your plan, as well as the benefit changes effective July 1, 2024. Below are some highlights:

- Member Cost Share Increases for All Plans: The PCP and specialist copayments will increase by \$5 each, the member coinsurance responsibility will increase by 5%, the coinsurance limit will increase by \$500 and the emergency room copayment will increase from \$200 to \$300.
- Fertility Benefits: Coverage is included for medically necessary fertility services. Medically necessary covered services include procedures to determine an individual's fertility and services such as artificial insemination, egg retrieval and cryopreservation, and in vitro fertilization. Please call Anthem Customer Service at the number on the back of your health plan ID card for additional information.
- Coverage for Recreational Prosthetics: Coverage is included for one prosthetic device that meets the medical needs of a participant under age 18 for recreational purposes.
- Aspire365: A long-term in-home treatment program that provides primary mental health, primary substance use, and co-occurring disorder treatment. Services can be coordinated with your schedule including in-person and telehealth sessions.
- Lark Diabetes Prevention Program: A personal diabetes prevention coaching program that can help you determine if you're at risk for prediabetes

- and, if needed, take steps to address it. Access Lark on the Sydney Health app.
- **Virgin Pulse Wellbeing Program:** Our Wellbeing program where you can track your steps, workouts, sleep and healthy habits, and quickly earn \$62.50 each quarter and up to \$250 after completing four quarters
