Unfortunately, we are contacting you to let you know that one of our district's schools, Mt. Blue Middle School will be going remote this week. Because of a large number of staff who will not be able to be at school along with a lack of substitutes, we will be forced to have Mt Blue Middle School go remote starting tomorrow Tuesday, January 18th, 2022 through Friday, January 21st.
