### Fun at summer learning camp

Students have been focusing on literacy, mathematics, science, and wellness at RSU 9's Summer Learning Camp at the W.G. Mallett School.

Future scientists have explored inquiry-based lessons as part of the "Be a Biologist" program. Students have explored changes in the



environment by taking on the role of a fisheries biologist and tested pH levels from water samples to determine if fish were being harmed by a pretend chemical spill. They will be exploring what it's like to be a wildlife biologist and learn about hummingbirds and what they need for survival; the final project is to design a feeder that will bring hummingbirds back to their preserve.



The program also promotes outdoor learning, providing opportunities for students to write, work with math facts, read, and participate in group skill-building sessions with their school counselor while enjoying all that nature has to offer! Excitement is high among the students and the staff tries to make learning fun by doing different activities every day. Some examples include painting numbers on the tar, sidewalk chalk, garden club, and group games to build team-building skills.
