Two people associated with RSU 9 schools have tested positive with COVID-19. The Maine CDC has notified district administration that they are backlogged and are working as quickly as possible to assign a case investigator. A case investigator is required by the CDC and will provide the district with the necessary guidance to allow us to begin contact tracing locally. As a result of this unfortunate delay, and in the best interest of our students and staff, Mt. Blue Middle School, Mt. Blue High School, and Foster Tech Center students will remain in full remote learning for the rest of this week (November 19th and November 20th). Parent Teacher Conferences for Mt. Blue Campus students will take place as scheduled on Thursday (11/19/20) via Zoom.
