WMU will host open tryouts for teams playing this fall. Players will participate in a variety of soccer drills and activities while being evaluated on their technical and tactical ability and coachability. Participants must be at least 7 years old and no older than 13 on August 1, 2025.

Players should arrive 20 minutes early to register for their session and get warmed up. If you have them, bring cleats, shin guards, and an age appropriate soccer ball (U8-U12 size 4, U13-U14 size 5) and PLENTY OF WATER!

There is no fee to participate in assessments. Registration fees for rostered players are \$90-\$125 due before league play starts - typically the last weekend in August. All players will need to purchase new uniforms this year (approximately \$100.00). It is Western Maine United policy that no child should be excluded from participation due to inability to pay. Financial assistance with fees and uniform costs is available to those with a demonstrated need.

WMU is also looking for volunteer coaches. If you might be interested in coaching a team, please contact us. The club will pay for your coaching certification classes.
