The Wilton Scholarship Foundation 2025 Application Instructions

<u>How does this work?</u> The Wilton Scholarship Foundation was founded in 1964 to help students from Wilton and its surrounding communities further their education. We administer several scholarships; you will be considered for all scholarships with this one application.

<u>Who is eligible?</u> Scholarships are intended for current and former graduates of Mt. Blue High School. To be eligible, you must be or have been a resident of Wilton, East Wilton, Weld, East Dixfield, or Dryden at your time of graduation from MBHS. Graduates from these towns or from Foster Career and Technical Education Center and Franklin County Adult Education are also eligible to apply.

<u>Who gets awards and how?</u> All eligible students who apply will receive an award based on need, the number of applicants, and the funds available each year. Award money will be mailed directly to your college at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters. Award winners will be notified in early June.

When are applications due? Applications must be postmarked no later than April 25. Late or incomplete applications will receive partial awards. Applications are available at the Wilton Town Office, online at the MBHS School Counseling Office website, or by request. Applications should be mailed to the Wilton Scholarship Foundation at the above postal address or emailed as an attachment to Lynn Ploof-Davis (lynnp@maine.edu). <u>How should I return the application?</u> The completed application should be returned in a document file format (PDF, Word, etc.) or by postal mail. Do not send a photo of the completed application. Additionally, please use the current year application form.

<u>What financial information is needed?</u> Because our scholarships are based on need, we require the following. Please fill in whichever applies on Question #4 of the application.

- a) If you filed the FAFSA, fill in your Student Aid Index located on your FAFSA submission summary.
- b) If you did not file the FAFSA, please write in the most recent taxable income (TI) for you or your family according to **your** category below:
 - *Dependent with married parents: Write in the combined TI for both parents.
 - *Dependent with single parent: Write in the TI for the parent who claims you on his/her taxes.
 - *Independent (single over 24, graduate student, or veteran): Write in your TI.
 - *Married: Write in the combined TI for you and your spouse.

<u>Confidentiality.</u> All financial information will be treated confidentially and shredded or deleted once the awards process is complete. Only two members of the awards committee will view this information.
